Eureka to McKinley Ave the route follow low traffic roads. The connection is signed and has partial bike lanes. After you cross McKinley Ave, the entrance to the Scioto Greenway is visible. Keep an eye out about 2 miles before Schrock Road where the trail crosses Westerville Rd (SR 3) and enters Cooper Park (5740 Cooper Rd), follow signs for Alum Creek Trail North through the park and along the Alum Creek. There is No Ohio to Erie Trail signage in Cooper Park, but follow the yellow dashed lines for the main trail.
