

CLEVELAND

SCRANTON FLATS TO WENDY PARK



CLEVELAND - Northbound

The Ohio to Erie Trail (OTET) follows the O&E Canalway Towpath Trail through Tremont and down to Scranton Flats. Travelers continue to follow the Towpath/OTET along Scranton Road, Carter Road, and over the Carter Rd Bridge. The Towpath/OTET then turns left and loops under Columbus Rd and goes into Canal Basin Park. The OTET leaves the Park on Merwin Ave and proceeds to Center St. At Center St the Trail turns right and goes over the Center St Swing Bridge. Riders make a sharp left turn at the end of the bridge and follow the bike path to the entrance of the Centennial Lake Link Trail. The OTET turns right and follows the Lake Link Trail by crossing over the Willow Ave Bridge and then the Wendy Park Bridge. At Wendy Park the OTET joins the Whiskey Island Connector which ends at Edgewater Park.

CLEVELAND - Southbound

The Ohio to Erie Trail (OTET) leaves Edgewater Park and goes east following the Whiskey Island Connector to Wendy Park. At Wendy Park the OTET joins the Centennial Lake Link Trail which crosses over the Wendy Park Bridge and then the Willow Ave Bridge before ending at Detroit. The OTET turns left and follows the bike path that goes north to Center Street. Riders turn right and cross the Center St Swing Bridge then turn left on Merwin Ave and enter Canal Basin Park. The OTET joins the O&E Canal Towpath Trail in the Park which goes under Columbus Rd and loops up and turns right to cross the Carter St Bridge. Travelers continue to follow the Towpath/OTET along Carter Road and Scranton Road as they go through Scranton Flats. The Towpath/OTET continues south as it travels through Tremont on the way to the Cuyahoga Valley NP.

From Xenia to the Ohio River in Cincinnati, connecting Spring Valley, Corwin, Fort Ancient, Morrow, Oregonia, South Lebanon, Loveland, Milford, Terrace Park, Avoca Park, and Newtown.
